FAMAGUSTA (L.C.T.(3) 430)

In connection with the Ministry of Transport enquiry into the loss of the above ship, it has been ascertained privately from the Admiralty that the ship was scheduled for the Far East, but the trip was cancelled due to the end of the war. Other vessels of the class made the voyage. It was emphasised that this information was of a confidential nature and should not be disclosed. If it is desired to make a statement in court on the matter, then the Secretary of the Admiralty should be asked for particulars, no mention being made of the details already obtained privately.
