This trawler stranded during a gale near
Brusand, Norway, on the 15th October, 1947.

Refloating was considered impracticable and
she is in course of being stripped.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

GILLSTONE. — Stavanger, Oct. 16. —
Trawler Gillstone, of Risør, on voyage
Bergen-Arendal, during gale grounded
near Brusand at 8 p.m. yesterday. Crew
landed but one man missing; weather
still boisterous. The Gillstone, is ex-
British trawler, reported sold to Norway
in 1946.


