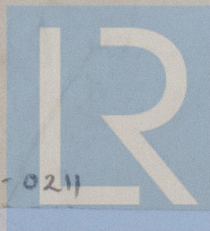
Dear Sir,

I beg to inform you that no deep tank is fitted forward, it was reported that No. 2 Hold was originally used as a deep ballast tank, but it appears that the water-tight hatches originally fitted have been replaced by an ordinary hatchway and in the circumstances this hold has been dealt with as a cargo space.
