I have to acquaint you that the s.s. "KERVEGAN" has been under survey at Nantes for freeboard assignment. As the vessel is now in the Tyne I shall be glad if you will check the sheers at one-eighth length from each end, and in this connexion I may add that the Society's Surveyors at Nantes have forwarded a sketch from which it appears that the sheer at one-eighth length forward would be about 1m.055 and at one-eighth length aft about 0m.515..

I shall also be glad if you will report the present lengths of the erections paying particular attention to any overhangs.
