I am in receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo regarding the freeboard for the s.s. "KERVEGAN", and with regard thereto I send herewith a memorandum setting forth the freeboards which have been assigned to this vessel. A memorandum is also enclosed for transmission to the Owners.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to arrange for the freeboards to be marked in accordance with the French Regulations, and for the usual French Freeboard verification of marking form to be forwarded to this Office in order that the certificates may be issued and a record made in the Register Book.

I shall also be glad if you will state the number of web plates fitted in No.4 hatchway, and you should inform the Owners that the blanking off of the side ballast tanks will not affect the freeboard assignment.

The plans forwarded for reference are returned herewith.
