Sir,

In reply to the enquiry contained in the Classing Letter of the 2nd instant respecting the steamer "KENBANE HEAD", I beg to state that the plating and the stiffening of the deep tank bulkhead are as approved.

With reference to the beams of the extended forecastle these were fitted two frame spaces apart of the scantlings required for beams on every frame, and the steel deck increased in thickness, and at our request were afterwards made equivalent to the Rules by fitting a reinforcing angle on the bottom edge of each beam.

The Ship Forging and Casting reports are enclosed as requested.
