Repairs due to war damage.

This vessel was sunk in war time and is now completely reconditioned.

All machinery was removed.

Crankshaft of main engine skinned, all bearings and bottom ends reinstalled. Liners drawn, cylinder block cleaned and examined, afterswells hydraulically tested. Main engine fuel pumps renewed. Thrustshaft skinned, pads renewed. Bedding and alignment of shafting examined.

Aux engines and pumps, several parts renewed and completely overhauled.

Electrical Equipment

The electrical equipment of this vessel has been completely renewed in accordance with the Rules.

Generators and motors overhauled, dried and varnished.

Main switch board overhauled, current breakers, amperes and voltmeters renewed and an automatic voltage regulator installed for shaft dynamo 5 K.W.

Materials used are of good quality and workmanship good. The installation tested under working condition, current breaker operated at 150% of full load.

On completion resistance of all circuits was found good.
