REPORT ON MASTS, SPARS, AND RIGGING.

gentlemen

Having, in accordance with your instructions, examined the Masts, Spars, and Rigging, and Iron Work of same, of the *S S Kildale*

I have to report that I found steel fore and main masts in good condition, wood fore and main topmasts sound.

Standing rigging on fore and main masts is in sound condition with exception of shackles and pins connecting same which show considerable wastage.

Wood derricks are in good condition excepting superficial defects through machine gun fire on No 4 starboard derrick which have been made good by additional steel bands.
