Waiting to hear from you as to the decision that may be come to by the Owners of these vessels,

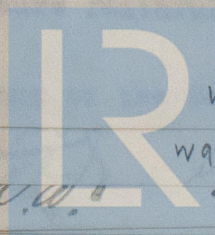
