We acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 23rd May and we know of no circumstances that would justify the continuation of this vessel's name in the Register Book.

As far as we are concerned, this boat was abandoned, in a sinking condition, in the position stated and although we have no eye witnesses to prove it, we have every reason to believe that the boat sank shortly afterwards and is not in a suitable position for salvaging.
