The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

(The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement.—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The MONTREAL Surveyors report (6.47) the vessel placed in dry dock, the greater part of a Periodical Special Survey (D) due 11.47 complied with, and repairs effected to cross and side bunkers and 'tween deck plating etc.

All items required for General Examination have been covered in this inspection and the Surveyors recommend a notation of "Examined 6.47" be assigned.

TO COMPLETE THE S.S.: - All D.B. tanks to be examined and tested, planking on main deck to be renewed as required and deck examined, the masts & rigging, windlass, pumps, W.T. doors and auxiliary steering gear to be examined, freeboard verified, and shell plating drill-tested.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed, with record of docking survey 6.47, and to have the notation of "Examined 6.47", valid for 12 months, assigned.
