1. Running aground off the North Coast of Skye on 15-11-43.
2. Drydocking in damaged condition at Swansea during the last week of December, 1943.
3. Grounding at the entrance to the Chesapeake and Delaware Canal on 27-9-43.
4. Causes unknown.

and that ~~I~~ <sup>we</sup> have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's

Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that <sup>temporary</sup> ~~all~~ repairs

recommended by ~~me~~ <sup>us</sup> have been completed to <sup>our</sup> ~~my~~ satisfaction, and

that ~~I~~ <sup>we</sup> have Recommended that she be continued as now classed,

without fresh record of survey, subject to permanent repairs to

forward bottom, side shell, internal structure and fittings being

effected on arrival at a U.S.A. port,

being fit to ~~carry~~ proceed in ballast (at draughts approximately 18ft. forward and 22 ft. aft).

The vessel's class is also subject to permanent repairs to indented poop sheerstrake plate No. 2 (port side aft), stem plate in 2nd below sheer, sheerstrake and bulwerk plate in way of No. 5 tank (port side) being effected at Owners' convenience.
