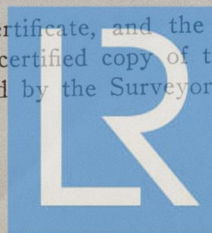
An Annual Survey has been carried out at this time in accordance with the Regulations of the Commandant, United States Coast Guard.
