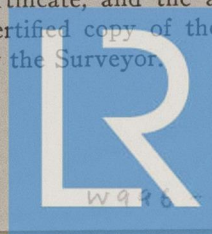
The Load Line Certificate has been endorsed in accordance with the provisions of the U. S. Department of Commerce Regulations.
