Dear Sir,

With reference to Glasgow Report No. 71592 on the Steamer "ONEIDA", I was directed to draw your special attention to this case by the Glasgow Sub-Committee of Classification, who had it under consideration at their Meeting to-day.

Attention is called to the condition of the vessel as reported and to the Surveyor's statement on his report, on information obtained from the Owners' Representative, that the vessel is laid up and for sale for breaking up purposes.

It is concluded that written confirmation of this will be obtained from the Owners in the usual course, in which case the vessel's class will be dealt with.

In the meantime the Committee consider that the notation "Laid up pending repairs" should be inserted in the Register Book.
