Bridge Deck Sheerstrake *84" in lieu of 76". Strake below sheerstrake 3 1/2" less in width than required but compensated for by increased thickness.*
Flat plate keel and adjoining strakes of approved thickness.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed **✱ 100A1 ("Steel") "awning deck** with freeboard," as recommended. The Summer freeboard of *13'-8 1/2"* from centre of disc to top of statutory deck line at *awning* deck, now marked on the vessel's sides, to be inserted in the classification certificate, and recorded in the Register Book, and further, the remaining freeboards, as shown on the accompanying verification form to be inserted in the certificate of classification.
