Harland & Wolff, I am directed to inform you that the matter received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, when it was decided that the equipment proposed by the Owners, as given below, would be approved for the figure 1.

480 fathoms	3½"	steel wire
130	"	7" steel wire
200	"	9" manilla hawser
600	"	8" " warp
40	"	12" " hawser.

It is noted that the anchors and chain cables proposed to be supplied will be in accordance with the requirements of Table 31 of the Society's Rules.
