It is stated by the Naval Officer in charge at this port that the above vessel has left Milford Haven some time, operating now from a port unknown to the authorities.

I could not get any information from the Naval Officer in charge as to whether an additional air receiver and two non-return valves in the lubricating oil system had been fitted or a set of spare valves for one main engine cylinder had been supplied.
