The ARUBA Surveyor reports (5.48) ship afloat and 45 fathoms of chain cable as above supplied and the marks verified with certificates.

It is submitted the ship is worthy to remain as classed, subject to repairs to the sternpost in way of No. 3 gudgeon and to the rudder mainpiece above 3rd arm being specially examined at the next drydocking, but without other condition.
