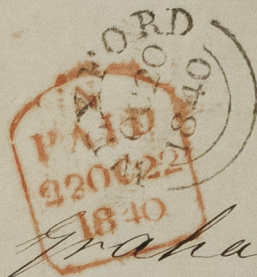
I forward you this day - a report of -
