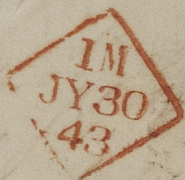

she deserves.

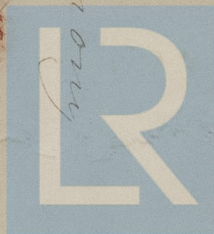
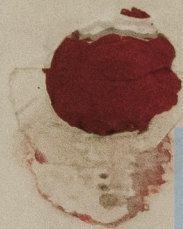
