Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the
recpt. of your letter of the 13 Inst. In reference
to the schooner "Power" 65 Tons built in
Barnstable in the year 1840. I surveyed while
building and when the vessel was completed
I went on board to see the stow in order to
fill up the report and send it off. The Master
informed me that all was on board except
the stream cable which he expected in a few
days and would let me know as soon as he
had it on board. This was on Friday the
next or following morning he said in a
conclusive manner

In respect of the vessel the frame and planking
was the size and description required for a
12 year ship. But she was built in a very short
time and a great portion of the timbers &
plank very green therefore I could not
