under special survey. I have ac-
-cordingly carefully examined
every frame so far as the work has
gone it has been well executed the
framing nearly completed. I enclose
particulars of build.

The Proprietors ask me could
this Vessel be classed A, 6 Years the
objection I see is deemed unnecessary being
Ash & counterbalance that the
stem & stern frames, their stop timbers
stanchions, apron knees & are British
and well squared & free from Lap, Kelsons,
Pitch Pine and all framing exceeding
the size required for even a much larger
Vessel. This Ash is of excellent quality.

If not too much against Rule it
might be granted as the Viceroy will be
well worthy of it


