## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

ACTIVE.—Wexford, Jan. 5. — Steamer Active, of London, Liverpool for Wexford, cargo wheat, foundered this morning between Lucifer and Blackwater Light-vessels. Crew landed at Rosslare Pier.

4. 6/1/22

ACTIVE.—Wexford, Jan. 6. — Steamer Active, of London, Hollywood, Liverpool for Wexford, wheat, experienced heavy weather and sea, during which she laboured heavily. At 5 a.m. on Jan. 5, when about two miles S.W. of Blackwater Light-vessel, the engineer reported that the vessel was making water. Pumps were set going and the master made for Wexford North Bay, the most convenient beaching place, but when about one mile inside Lucifer the engines stopped owing to the water rising and the vessel afterwards sank. Crew took to the boat and landed at Rosslare Pier.
