CAPE BRETON. — *Sydney (C.B.), March 7.* — British steamer Cape Breton drove ashore at Scatari in consequence of a heavy gale and is likely to become a total wreck. Steamer standing by.

CAPE BRETON. — *Sydney (C.B.), March 8.* — British steamer Cape Breton: Further reports state vessel broken in two. Wilson will hold survey.

CAPE BRETON. — *North Sydney (N.S.), March 12.* — Steamer Cape Breton has been surveyed and condemned, and will be sold.

CAPE BRETON. — *North Sydney (C.B.), March 19.* — The hull of the wrecked steamer Cape Breton was sold on March 17 for 2845 dols.
