Copy of a letter received from the Society's Surveyor at
Mobile, Ala. Dated 9th June. Received 19th June, 1923.

Dear Sir,

Sailing Vessels "DOVA LISBOA" & "DOVA RIO".

Reverting to your marconigram of the 10th April
last and your confirmation of same date, I beg to advise
you that I have examined both these vessels on dry dock.
Several minor repairs have been made and the crew are now
overhauling the rigging, also scaling and painting the
iron work.

As there is no immediate prospect of the vessels
being chartered, enquiries are being made with a view of
carrying out the requirements of Special Surveys now due;
in the meantime the Captain is waiting for instructions
from the Owners.

Work in hand is proceeding very slowly; as soon as
repairs have been completed I will advise you accordingly.
