In March last the Committee agreed to a proposal to postpone the above survey until the vessel's return from a voyage to the Mediterranean in about two months' time, subject to the vessel being generally examined and found in a fit condition for the voyage. The Liverpool Surveyors reported in April they had made a general examination of the vessel and as far as seen she appeared to be in an efficient condition. They recommended that the Special Survey should be carried out on her return from her present voyage in about two months' time.

The Liverpool Surveyors now write enclosing a

"In view of the inspection of the Boilers on this

and will do so, unless we hear from you to the contrary."

April last state that in their opinion the Owners' proposal
merits the Committee's approval.
