

Portion of Survey held, &c.,

The 3rd. S.S. No. 2, due 10.19, has been partly held by the examination of the foremast and fore rigging.

A proposal to postpone the special survey until the vessel's arrival in Europe from New York via Buenos Aires was agreed to in November last.

The Copenhagen Surveyors now state the vessel is at present laid up at Svendborg, and that it is the Owners' intention to have the special survey completed before she again proceeds to sea, and he requests that the class may remain undisturbed so long as she is laid up.

It is submitted action be deferred and the Owners asked to furnish the usual undertaking.
