SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

MOUNT STEWART (s).—Dover, July 24, 7 50 a.m.—Screw steamer Trinidad, of London, from Bilbao for Middlesbrough (iron ore), anchored in bay with damage to bows, reported by captain to be not serious, after collision this morning with steamer reported Mount Stewart, of Sunderland, westward of Dover. Damage to latter unknown. Tugs gone in search. Weather foggy. Captain of Trinidad states he is proceeding for destination.

MOUNT STEWART (s).—Sandgate, July 24, 8 5 a.m.—Collision between Trinidad and Mount Stewart (s), of Sunderland, off Folkestone, at 3 30 this morning; weather thick. Latter vessel sunk. Crew landed at Folkestone. Trinidad supposed to have proceeded.—[See Dover paragraph.]

MOUNT STEWART (s).—Dover, July 24, 9 a.m.—Trinidad: Captain now reports about 15 to 20 tons of water in fore compartment. Has commenced jettison cargo from forehold, and purposes discharging 20 to 30 tons, and states will then proceed. Tugs returned from westward, have found no trace of other steamer.

MOUNT STEWART (s).—Folkestone, July 24.—The spot at which the Mount Stewart (s), of Sunderland, which was sunk off here by collision this morning, lies, is given as four miles SSE of Folkestone. Two masts are visible at half-tide.
