## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

**WAIRARAPA** (s).—*Sydney*, Nov. 1, noon.—Wairarapa (British steamer), Sydney for Auckland, totally wrecked Barrier Island. Captain, 23 of the crew, and 111 passengers drowned.—[See Auckland paragraph below.]  
**WAIRARAPA** (s).—*Auckland*, Nov. 1, 1 10 p.m.—Wairarapa, Mackintosh, Sydney for Auckland, wrecked and totally lost ship and cargo, at Great Barrier Island; 81 passengers and 40 crew saved and landed at Auckland. Captain, 20 crew, and 58 passengers drowned.—[Another report states that the above steamer was lost on Sunday night.]
