R. With reference to my letter of the 13th instant respecting the Screw Trawler "REGAL", to which I do not appear to have been favoured with a reply I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel before them at their meeting to-day, and I am directed to inform you that, after consideration of the circumstances they feel that, consistently with the course followed in similar instances a record of the stranding of the vessel should be made against her name in the Register Book as described in my letter referred to above.

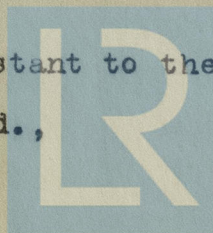
