Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 20th, respecting the Steamer "ST NICOLAS".

In reply thereto, I beg to inform you that, the Official of the Marine Militaire, who has been communicated with, explained that the vessel is completely grounded and, as far as he knows, the bow is torn open for about 2 meters.

The French Authorities ( Administration des Domaines )  
as by auctions will sell the vessel at Brest, on the 12th February, and they do not intend to do anything in regard to the salvage of the vessel, leaving this question to the Buyers. But, in view of the fact, that the French Authorities expect to find a buyer, it can't be considered that there are good prospects of salvage.
