Précis of particulars of Casualty
Vessel is reported from North Sydney (C.B.), to have gone ashore at Newhaven, Cape Breton, on July 29, 1921, and to have become a total loss.
Owners concur.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

VOLUNDA.—North Sydney (C.B.), July 29.—British steamer Volunda got ashore at Newhaven. Pounding heavily forward. Assistance is with her.

VOLUNDA.—North Sydney (C.B.), July 31.—Steamer Volunda ashore Neils Harbour Ledges, Cape Breton. Partially sheltered by outside reefs otherwise exposed everything North South through East. Forepeak Nos. 1 and 2 holds pierced and full sea level, machinery space flooded, all abaft this in order, no signs straining apparent. Vessel hard on forward to No. 3. Fear have to jettison half or two-thirds coal cargo.—Salvage Association's Special Officer.

VOLUNDA.—North Sydney (C.B.), Aug. 3.—Steamer Volunda: Effect Monday's gale now renders salvage negligible. Strongly recommend sell prompt.—Salvage Association's Surveyor.

VOLUNDA.—Halifax (N.S.), Aug. 5.—Steamer Volunda: American Underwriters agreed owners arrange sale vessel and cargo Monday next (Aug. 8). Salvors positively refused any stripping contracts. Position now hopeless.—Salvage Association's Surveyor.

VOLUNDA.—North Sydney (C.B.), July 29.—The steamer Volunda, which was wrecked at Newhaven, was sent there on her way to Montreal to render assistance to the inhabitants of Newhaven and Neir's Harbour, who were driven into their boats by forest fires. It is understood that Newhaven has been utterly destroyed.
