Dear Sirs,

Re steamer "WESTRALIA" which I understand (from Press, and our telephone conversation yesterday) you have bought from Messrs. Huddart Parker Ltd, will be converted into a hulk and towed to the Islands.

This vessel's Class remained undisturbed, provided a complete Special Survey 3rd No. I was held in its entirety before vessel proceeded to sea, this decided upon by Lloyd's Register London Committee as far back as 29th May 1925 in a letter to Messrs. Huddart Parker Ltd, Melbourne.

As nothing has been done in the way of Surveys, and the year of grace having expired May 1925, I have advised London re the change of Ownership, and deletion of vessel's Class from the Register Book.
