Dear Sirs,

R. With reference to my letter of the 2nd February last and previous correspondence respecting the steamer "WHINSTONE", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have again had the case of this vessel under consideration at their meeting to-day, and I am directed to inform you that, after careful consideration of all the circumstances they feel that, consistently with the course followed in similar instances, a record of the stranding of the vessel should be made against her name in the Register Book as described in my letter of the 23rd December last.

I may add, however, that in the event of the vessel being refloated and repaired to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors the notation of casualty will be withdrawn immediately upon reclassification by this Society.

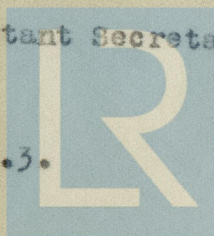
