will see by my report that I noticed
the error of the main breadth which I
pointed out to the customs Surveyor who on
remeasuring the vessel made the correction

Am I to charge Mr Smales the new
owner the fee for change of owners she was
classed on Friday & he purchased & became
owner on the following day
